Students are to be dropped off at Grace Community Church (2853 Dunlop Ln.) on Sunday, June 21st at 2:00 PM. Students will travel to camp by 2 charter busses. Students will arrive back at Grace on Thursday, June 25th at 1:00 PM.

## TIME AWAY CARDS

If your student will need to leave High School Camp due to a game, competition, doctor's appointment, etc., we ask that you complete and turn in a Time Away Card during registration on Sunday afternoon. It is important for our staff and leaders to know about your arrangement ahead of time so that we can ensure that every student is accounted for.
